070-VA (13 min. serious)	Bloodborne Pathogens: What Are They? Covers different types of viruses found in the blood. Tells of symptoms to look for and how each one is transmitted. (HIV, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and Syphilis)
070-DC (DVD ONLY) (16 min. serious)	Emergency First Aid This video provides basic information that will help you properly apply first aid when needed. Topics included in this safety video are: emergencies, shock, CPR, heart attack, bleeding, poisoning/overdose, and near-drownings.
070-VD (10 min. graphic)	Hand and Finger Injuries Gives examples of cuts and burns, and what you should do to care for the victim.
070-VE (11 min. humorous)	Bloodborne Pathogens: Post Exposure Covers what steps to take if you have been exposed to infected blood.
070-DF (DVD ONLY) 12 min. serious)	Bloodborne Pathogens for Non-Healthcare Employees Covers: 1) Transmission routes 2) preparation for emergencies and first aid 3) housekeeping and waste disposal 4) definition of bloodborne pathogens, HBV, HIV, AIDS.
