070-VA	Bloodborne Pathogens: What Are They?
(13 min. serious)	Covers different types of viruses found in the blood. Tells of symptoms to look for and how each one is transmitted. (HIV, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and Syphilis)
070-DC (DVD ONLY) Emergency First Aid
(16 min. serious)	This video provides basic information that will help you properly apply first aid when needed. Topics included in this safety video are: emergencies, shock, CPR, heart attack, bleeding, poisoning/overdose, and near-drownings.
070-VD	Hand and Finger Injuries
(10 min. graphic)	Gives examples of cuts and burns, and what you should do to care for the victim.
070-VE	Bloodborne Pathogens: Post Exposure
(11 min. humorous)	Covers what steps to take if you have been exposed to infected blood.
070-DF (DVD ONLY) Bloodborne Pathogens for Non-Healthcare Employees	
12 min. serious)	Covers: 1) Transmission routes 2) preparation for emergencies and first aid 3) housekeeping and waste disposal 4) definition of bloodborne pathogens, HBV, HIV, AIDS.
